Scholarship Guidelines

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. The applicant must be an active member of Tabernacle Baptist Church for at least 2 years prior to the current scholarship calendar year.
- 2. The applicant must graduate from high school in the current scholarship calendar year.
- 3. The applicant must show proof of enrollment in an 2 or 4 year accredited college or university.
- 4. The applicant must submit a completed packet by June 19, 2023 of the current scholarship calendar year. The completed scholarship packet must contain the following:
 - a. The completed application
 - b. One copy of the student's official transcript
 - c. Two letters of recommendation (one should come from a teacher, school faculty and one letter from the Pastor)
 - d. Proof of enrollment
 - e. A one or two page typed essay on the topic provided (typed double spaced; 12 point font)

Selection Criteria

A committee will interview the applicant. Interviews will take place the week of June 19, 2023. The applicant will receive points based on the following:

- 1. Essay
- 2. Completed Application
- 3. Church Participation
- 4. Two Letters of Recommendation
- 5. GPA
- 6. Interview

Note: For consideration, all information requested must be included with the application and received by the deadline, incomplete applications will not be considered.
